Adding Text Slides

Tech slides are divider slides that can be placed in the media asset swim lane alongside your video clip and image assets.

These are individual instance assets that you create yourself during the smash building process.

Text slides can be used to add text between assets as an introduction slide, end slide, and more.

Let's navigate to the text tab in the assets library.

You can add a slide to your smash one of two ways.

First, you can click and drag the blank slide asset and drop it where you want it in your smash.

The second way you can add a slide is by clicking the three dot more menu and adding to the beginning or end of the smash.

I'm going to create an introduction slide so I will drop this at the beginning of my smash.

You will notice once you drop your slide, you will be taken into the slide creator.

You can add custom text to your slide and choose basic formatting options.

I can choose between small, medium, and large text.

You can also position the text left, center, or right aligned and choose whether it will display top, center, or bottom of the screen.

Once you are finished customizing your slide, you can click save.
