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To start making your first clip, simply click the start clipping button.

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The clipping toolbar will appear.

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From here you have a few options.

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You can click the play button and the clipping area will start to expand.

You can also adjust the clipping area by dragging the end and the start handlebars, or you can also use the frame by frame arrows to control the start or end frame of the clipping area.

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Once you are satisfied with your clipping, click the end clipping button.

You can still watch your selection with the preview button and make changes using the handlebars and frame by frame arrows.

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If you are satisfied, you can go ahead and click the save clip button.

You will then be asked to name your clip and you can decide to add tags to the clip.

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If you are making a lot of clips, adding tags can help you find clips on the dashboard and in the smash builder.

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Lastly, you'll choose how you want.
