Trimming Media Assets

We've added a couple of basic editing features in the Smash Builder.

One of these features is trimming.

[00:00:15]

We designed trimming to help you finesse your video and clip assets.

[00:00:18]

Once you have brought them into the Smash Builder, trimming lets you adjust the start and end point of a video or clip asset in the smash Smash Builder.

This only changes the way the clip or video appears in this specific smash.

If you navigate back to your dashboard and head into your my clips library, you will still see the full clip remains the initial length.

The same thing happens if you trimmed a video in a smash the video on your my videos library is untouched.

You can access the trimming feature by either clicking the three dot more menu or by right clicking on a clip or video asset once you have added it to the smash timeline.

After you have selected trim all of your other assets on the timeline will be disabled.

[00:01:06]

You are now in the trimming mode.

[00:01:08]

You can adjust the start and end points of this asset by either dragging the start and end handlebars or by adjusting frame by frame.

In this example Smash, I wanted to lead into each of my clips with an image of the start frame of that clip.

However, in this clip I didn't start it at the exact frame as my image.

[00:01:29]

I just quickly want to adjust the start point of this clip so that it matches this image here.

[00:01:35]

I can finesse this by using the frame by frame button to make sure I have what I want.

[00:01:42]

You will also notice we have included the original smash duration, the new duration after the trim, and what that change is.

[00:01:49]

We thought this information could be helpful for you if you are looking to keep your smash to a certain time.

In this example, if we wanted to make a 4 minute smash, we would know we need to shave five more seconds off of either this clip asset or another asset in order to achieve that.

Once you are finished trimming, just click save.

[00:02:10]

Just to reiterate, this is not a destructive behavior you have not cut or trimmed this clip permanently.

[00:02:18]

You can modify or edit this trim in the same way.

[00:02:21]

Click the three dot menu and select trim.

[00:02:24]

This will open up the same interface and allow you to adjust back to the original clip length or trim more of your clip if desired.
